



Poster Session

This session is dedicated to the presentation of research outcomes. Presenters will deliver 4-minute flash talks, based on their previously submitted posters. Following the presentations, participants will move to individual Zoom breakout rooms for Q&A sessions. Presenters will be organized into several groups, as flash talks are conducted in parallel. Best Poster Awards will be presented, based on anonymous evaluations by faculty members from participating universities. The award is open to students and young researchers who are under the age of 40 as of December 3, 2025.

Participation Guidelines for the Poster Session

We are widely accepting research posters regardless of the symposium theme.

♦ Pre-Symposium Preparation (1): Registration

Both poster presenters and non-presenters use the same registration form. However, by answering "Yes" to the question "Are you a poster presenter?", you will be registered as a poster presenter.

♦ Pre-Symposium Preparation (2): After Registration

After the poster submission deadline, all posters will be made available to all participants as early as possible. Participants are encouraged to review the posters in advance and submit questions or comments through the system. Poster presenters are expected to respond to these questions and comments prior to the day of the symposium.

How to leave your comments: The PDF posters will be stored on OneDrive, and participants will be able to leave comments on them. To add a comment, open the desired poster in OneDrive, highlight the section you want to comment on by dragging your cursor over it, and then click the "Comment" button in the top-right corner to enter your comment. Presenters will be able to respond individually to each comment received. ◆ On the Day of the Symposium (December 2)

Presenters will be assigned to breakout groups according to the three thematic fields: Environmental Technology, Natural Resources, and Global Ecology.

Presentations will take place in separate Zoom breakout rooms, with each group divided into two sessions.

Each presenter will give a short flash presentation using one PowerPoint slide. The presentation time per person will be approximately 2–4 minutes, depending on the number of participants.

Even for participants attending in person, it is not necessary to bring a printed poster, as a computer for presentations will be provided at the venue.

At the closing of the symposium, the Best Poster Presentation Award will be announced. The award is open to students and early-career researchers under the age of 40 as of December 2, 2025.

Poster Evaluation and Feedback

All poster presentations will be evaluated by faculty members from participating universities based on the following four criteria (5-point scale):

- 1. Significance and novelty of the research
- 2. Clarity and structure of the poster content
- 3. Relevance of results and discussion
- 4. Effectiveness of the oral presentation during the session (presentation skills, clarity, interaction with audience)

Final scores will be calculated by combining pre-symposium review scores with the on-the-day presentation score.

After the symposium, each poster presenter will receive their score and at least one comment from a reviewer.

♦ Important Notes

Poster replacements, modifications, or late submissions will not be accepted under any circumstances.

Once submitted, posters are considered final and will be used for evaluation and symposium presentation.





Distance from Santika Hotel Baranangsiang : 10,5 km (29 minute)







Distance from IPB Dramaga Campus: 13,2km (30-60 minutes)

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



Distance from IPB Dramaga Campus: 13,6km (30-60 minutes)


